

SCLEROTHERAPY

Thread Vein Treatment (Face)

Thread veins lie under the membrane layer of the skin. If left untreated, the condition can become increasingly widespread and unsightly. Sclerotherapy is by far the most effective procedure for removing thread veins.



This treatment involves a special solution being injected into the veins through a very small needle causing the walls of the veins to contract and eventually making them disappear completely.

At consultation Dr Saleh will discuss with you any relevant medical history, try to ascertain your expectations, determine your suitability for treatment and then discuss possible treatment options for you to consider.

Dr Saleh will explain the treatment processes and any possible risks and complications and provide you with post treatment advice.

If you are having a course of treatments, please make an appointment for four weeks. When a course is complete, it is advisable to have an annual treatment to maintain the optimum result.

Following Your Treatment

After treatment of face thread veins, do not apply make-up until the following day. The marks from the treatment will usually settle within 48–72 hours.

Depending on the severity of the thread veins, there may be bruising or swelling for one week.

Allergic response to such treatment is rare, as is infection. However, if you experience any unusual symptoms in the treated area, please contact the clinic as soon as possible.
